- In 2015 the group had no other meeting than that in Malmö annual meeting.

The Scandinavian urethroplasty study: A multicentre, prospective, randomized study comparing bulbar urethroplasty with excision and primary anastomosis or with an onlay grafting procedure using buccal mucosa started in 2016. That study is now taken care of an unofficial subgroup of reconstructive urologists handling urethroplasties. Participating hospitals are Oslo, Gothenburg and Helsinki. Örebro and Aalborg are in about to start recruiting patients.

In 2016 some members of the group (Sairanen, Nilsen, Sander, Olsen) attended Imoru meeting in Hamburg. In that occasion a conversational meeting was held. No other meeting was held that year.
